

Waste Warrior (Green Depot Volunteer) Application

What is the Green Depot?

The Green Depot is the local recycling centre that offers its services to residents of the University Neighbourhoods, as well as staff, faculty, and students of UBC. The Green Depot aims to divert unnecessary waste from the landfill and decrease the community's impact on climate change. This is accomplished through the re-use and recycling of items.

The Green Depot is run 100% by volunteers, on a day to day basis.

What are the responsibilities of a Waste Warrior (Green Depot Volunteer)?

Waste Warriors are responsible for guiding and assisting visitors at the Green Depot. They ensure that all dropped off items are properly sorted and that none of the waste streams are contaminated. Waste Warriors are also responsible for keeping track of the number of residents to the Depot and answering any questions that residents may have.

What is the time commitment of a Waste Warrior?

Waste Warriors are asked to commit to the same two-hour shift, every week. There is some flexibility with regards to exam schedules, holidays, etc.
