

## **Green Depot Waste Warrior Volunteer Posting**

### **What is the Green Depot?**

The Green Depot is a Recycling Service that has been available to UNA and UBC community members since 2015. The Depot offers an easy and accessible way to recycle and responsibly dispose of a wide variety of materials not normally accepted in residential disposal services. The Green Depot is managed by the University Neighbourhoods Association and run by a part-time staff person and several dedicated volunteers.

Green Depot Waste Warriors are the incredible youth volunteer team that make the operation of The Green Depot possible. Our Waste Warriors are extremely dedicated community youth who have dedicated their time to strengthen the UNA community and decrease the amount of unnecessary waste going into the landfill. Without the Waste Warriors, the Green Depot would not be possible!

### **Who is a Waste Warrior?**

- Friendly and polite to all Green Depot users and fellow Waste Warriors
- Interested in sustainability
- Able to commit to regular, weekly shifts
- 15 years or older

### **Waste Warrior Responsibilities**

- Guide Green Depot users in separating their waste correctly
- Ensure that all dropped off items are properly sorted and that the waste streams are not contaminated
- Tracking the number of residents and quantity of materials dropped off
- Explain recycling information to Green Depot users and answer any questions
- Stayed informed of all Green Depot operations and ask if I am unsure

### **Waste Warrior Time Commitment**

Waste Warriors are asked to commit to a consistent shift every week. There is some flexibility with regards to exam schedules, holidays, etc.

We are currently looking to cover or create the following shifts

- Mondays, 4-7pm – starting in June until September
- Saturday OR Sunday – shift time depending on volunteers' schedule (will discuss with UNA Sustainability Specialist)

### **Waste Warrior Duos**

Ideally, all Waste Warriors volunteer with a partner, making the volunteering experience more fun and collaborative. This also enables you to leave the Green Depot for a few minutes (for the washroom, food, coffee, etc.) while leaving the Depot open and available to residents. We will do our best to have two volunteers for each shift.
