OBJECTIVE

Storytime at the Old Barn Leader is a volunteer position that provides a group experience for young children and their caregivers.

OVERALL GOALS FOR THE POSITION

1. Create a welcoming and inclusive environment for young children and their caregivers.
2. Provide an early literacy experience and an introduction to group activities.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Plan age appropriate stories, songs, and movement opportunities for children ages 0-4 years.
2. Develop positive relationships with participants to help build a sense of community.
3. Ensure the room is clean and tidy at the end of the session.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be age 16+
- Fluency in English.
- An interest in Early Childhood Education and promoting a positive group social experience.
- Enthusiasm and patience.
- Must obtain a Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sectors Clearance prior to starting (online link or request letter will be provided)
