OBJECTIVE

The Tech-Savvy Seniors Program volunteers empower seniors to learn how to use their smart phones, tablets, and laptops.

OVERALL GOALS FOR THE POSITION

- Enable the seniors in our community to be better connected through better use of technology.

- 3. Empower seniors by providing tools and resources for self-learning.
