OBJECTIVE

Storytime Leader is a volunteer position that offers valuable opportunities for personal growth, leadership development, and provides a safe and welcoming experience for parents and care givers with babies through a session of rhymes, songs and stories to support early development.

OVERALL GOALS FOR THE POSITION

1. Support babies and children's early development through songs and stories.
2. Creating a welcoming and inclusive environment where care givers and parents in the community can foster connection.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Leading a 30-minute session of rhymes, songs and stories for children and families and care givers to follow along to.
- Preparing stories and songs to be facilitated during the 30-minute session.
- Promoting a positive learning environment that encourages opportunities for physical and social development.
- Develop positive relationships with children and their parents and care givers to help build a sense of community.
- Ensure the room is clean and tidy at the end of the session.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Strong understanding and commitment to supporting healthy early childhood development.
- Passion for community engagement.
- Enthusiasm and patience.
- Must obtain a Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sectors Clearance prior to starting (online link or request letter will be provided).
