### OBJECTIVE

Co-facilitate a French conversation club where participants practice speaking French in a casual, supportive environment, with conversations centred around a chosen weekly topic. This is not an instructed language class. While the group may learn some new words, the focus is on gaining confidence using skills acquired elsewhere.

### ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Weekly, one-hour sessions
- Set up/clean up some basic supplies
- Ensure a welcoming and inclusive environment
- Receive feedback from participants
- Work with other co-leader to decide on weekly conversation topics and occasionally gather French learning resources for sharing

### REQUIREMENTS:

- Conversational Level French
- Professional communication with participants and staff
- Be able to commit to volunteering for most of a term (12 sessions)
- Must obtain a Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sectors Clearance prior to starting (online link or request letter will be provided).
