OBJECTIVE

Facilitate a drop-in program for people to work on self directed, individual or group sewing and knitting projects. This is an excellent opportunity for friends to work together.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Weekly, two-hour sessions
- Set up some basic supplies (sewing machines, knitting needles)
- Ensure a welcoming and inclusive environment
- Receive feedback from participants
- Ensure that participants clean up after themselves and that the room is clean at the end of each session

REQUIREMENTS:

- Familiarity with sewing machines or willingness to learn
- Knowledge of basic sewing and/or knitting/crocheting techniques
- Knowledge of Mandarin is an asset
- Must have a good work ethic (be reliable and punctual)
- Professional communication with participants and staff
- Be able to commit to volunteering for most of a term (10 sessions)
- Must obtain a Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sectors Clearance prior to starting (online link or request letter will be provided).
