

UNA FIELDS THIRD PARTY RENTALS POLICIES

Updated: December 17th, 2020.

Arrival on Site

- Arrive no earlier than 10 minutes prior to your booking time
- Proceed directly to your booked field
- Do not enter the field until your booked time
- Enter through the appropriate gate or pathway, as designated by your affiliate organizations COVID-19 Return to Play documentation
- Masks must be worn in situations where physical distancing is not possible.
- Depart immediately after your booking has ended
- Spectators are not permitted at this time unless in direct care of child or youth.
- No adult sport is permitted at this time

Contact Tracing

The UNA may request, for contact tracing purposes, the first and last names and telephone number, or email address of all participants, for each day of activity on the field.

UNA Community Field and Nobel Field: General Policies for All Groups

- Anyone with symptoms of COVID-19 should not participate in activities on the field
 - No games are permitted at this time
 - 3 meters of physical distance must be followed at all times on the field of play
- Physical distancing must be followed at all times outside of the field of play, this includes:
 - o pathways
 - o sidelines
 - o team bench areas
- No spitting
- No team huddles
- All activity must comply with Provincial Sport Organization Return to Play Guidelines
- Spectators are not permitted at this time
 - Total number of participants on the field must not exceed 50 persons
- Water bottles, towels, pinnies, clothing, food must not be shared
- A first aid protocol must be submitted prior to the start of your booking
- No adult sport is permitted at this time



UNA Community Field and Nobel Field: General Policies for Sport Field Use

- Covered team benches are to be used only for storage of personal items. Only one person is allowed in the team bench area at one time
- Goals may be used, but must be wiped down with disinfectant after use
- Hands must be sanitized or washed prior to entering the playing surface
- Hand sanitizer may not be used on the playing surface (turf field)
- Shared equipment must be disinfected before, during and after use
 - o This includes balls, discs, cones, nets, goals etc.
- Equipment should not be touched by hands unless necessary
 - Anything shared by hand should be sanitized frequently

Soccer

- Throw-ins are not permitted in practice, ball must be kicked-in instead
- Goalies must not share gloves
- Games are not permitted at this time
- 3 meters of distance must be maintained at all times while on the field of play

Softball/Baseball

- Ball must be sanitized frequently
- Bat must be sanitized between users
- No spitting
- No chewing gum, no sunflower seeds
- No sharing of helmets, gloves, hats, or other equipment Dugouts are to be used only for storage of personal items. Only one person is allowed in the dugout at one time.
- Games are not permitted at this time
- 3 meters of distance must be maintained at all times while on the field of play

Flag Football/Football

- Tackle football is not permitted at this time
- Ball must be sanitized frequently
- No spitting
- No sharing of helmets, pads, or gloves
- Games are not permitted at this time
- 3 meters of distance must be maintained at all times while on the field of play
