

UNA COMMUNITY GARDENS PROGRAM

GARDEN APPLICATION + ASSIGNMENT PROCESS

Steps

1. Ensure that you are a UNA resident, with an active UNA Access Card
2. Read the Community Garden Terms & Conditions (online)
3. Fill out the online Community Garden application
4. Wait to be contacted with a community garden plot offer (1-2 years for Rhodo and Hawthorn, 2-4 years for Nobel garden)
5. Accept plot offer and submit plot payment

Waitlist + Plot Assignment

- Each garden has a separate waitlist
- Waitlist order is determined by garden application date (i.e. first-come-first-serve).
- Gardeners can accept a plot in their non-preferred garden, while they wait for a plot in their preferred garden. Gardeners who choose to do this, will not lose their spot on the waitlist for their preferred garden.

For example: If John Smith wants a plot in Nobel Community garden, but is offered a plot in Hawthorn community garden, he can still accept the Hawthorn plot without losing his place on the Nobel garden waitlist.

After Plot Assignment

1. Confirm plot assignment by submitting payment online, or in-person at the Old Barn Community Centre or Wesbrook Community Centre
2. Pick-up garden key from Old Barn Community Centre or Wesbrook Community Centre (for Hawthorn and Nobel only)
3. Receive contact information for community garden representative
4. Review Community Garden Standards and Community Garden Terms & Conditions
5. Start gardening!

Garden Fees

- \$55 for standard plot
- \$30 for a half plot (Nobel only)

No prorated fees are given to gardeners who are offered a plot later in the season. There is no fee associated with participating in the Old Barn Children's Garden.
